The combination of features, mission, and heritage of the Norris Bible Baptist Seminary make it a one-of-a-kind preacher training center. It was established in 1984, to largely mirror the Bible Baptist Seminary of Ft. Worth (which had its beginning in 1939, under the leadership of J. Frank Norris and Louis Entzminger). A school

which was committed to a thoroughgoing teaching of the whole English Bible, while also instilling within its students a fervency for evangelism, worldwide church planting, doctrinal and practical preaching in keeping with the historic Baptist faith. Both Norris and Entzminger, in spite of having been educated in the typical fashion of denominational schools (Norris having graduated from a prominent college among denominational Baptists, then afterwards at the top of his class from their premier seminary), felt their approach was a marked improvement. Time has repeatedly proven them right.

And why not? The Bible is unique in its quality! For example, if there were two libraries,

and one had all the books that have ever been written but no Bible; and the other had only one book, a Bible, which would be the best library, the most relevant to mankind? The Bible is also unique in its vitality! It is a living book! It is said to be "quick" (which means "alive" Hebrews 4:12, I Corinthians 15:45; Ephesians 2:1-5ff) and powerful. It is compared to a seed which has life in itself (I Peter 1:22-25). It is likened unto a branch that is engrafted (James 1:21). It has the breath of God in it (II Timothy 3:16-17); like Adam of old (Genesis 2:6-7) who was an extravagant sculpture beyond any other and yet merely statuesque, until He was



breathed into by God; then he became an animated (living) sculpture! Furthermore, the Bible is unique in its instrumentality! It is the "sword of the Spirit." In keeping with God's own analogy, what a surgeon does with a knife or with a laser, cannot compare with what the Spirit does in the heart of a man with the Word of God! Whereby He pierces "even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit" – the innermost part of man, hence, the "thoughts and intents of the heart" are uniquely discerned (Hebrews 4:12).

Therefore, in a world that is increasingly high-tech, nothing still is as cutting-edge as the Bible. By its very nature, it will always be the most advanced, and yet settled presentation of truth there will ever be. What can be more modern than a book of timeless truths given by an eternal and all-knowing Creator? Because God is outside of time and sees the past, present, and future all at once, He can impart truth that is ageless. Nothing could be more state-of-the-art and up-to-date than His Word. The Bible is a book that is proactive, prescient, and penetrating in its message in ways no other writing could ever be (Psalm 119; Galatians 3:8; Il Timothy 3:16-17 – "throughly furnished"). Hence, we are compelled to teach the Bible in a truly comprehensive manner (all 66 books twice). The better it is taught to

preachers, the more relevant will be their training. Better includes quantity, and 24 of our 48 courses are in Bible exposition. As Christ prayed, "Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth." John 17:17.

We know of no other place where your foundational Bible training will be as Biblically thoroughgoing and ministry directed (14 practical courses) as it will be at NBBS. Other areas of learning are indeed relevant, but a distant second in priority; so "first things first" preacher, have done with the peripheral course approach.



We are ready to start our 36th fall semester with a new A/C system! Hymnals are as Hebrews 11:1-12:3 set to song, especially when Christians know the biographies of the writers of the songs (both music and lyrics), and the stories behind the hymns. Students are also directed to use this musical heritage as a reference point in the development of their music program in their churches, as well as the primary feature to it. Overall, the doctrinal content and theological expression in the hymns is unsurpassed, and they help to protect from the corrosive influences put upon churches of today.
