Genesis 3:15 · History is His Story! · Hebrews 2:14-16

In relation to the Scriptures, creation, and Christ, God has also revealed Himself in history. History, within the inspired Word of God, provides mankind with an infallible historical revelation. Yet history in general can also be very instructive, especially when studied according to a Christian worldview. Scripture provides the context of a definite starting point and ending point to history. The grand Creator of all is seen to be not only the gracious Curator of it, but also the grand Consummator of all (Romans 11:33-36). J. Frank Norris, told the students at the old Bible Baptist



Seminary, "Do not judge the Bible by world history, but judge world history by the Bible." In keeping with this, he would give impromptu lectures to them on world history as it related to the Bible.

Students at NBBS, beginning with the undergraduate bachelor's degree program, are inundated with history. In the same spirit of Dr. Norris, NBBS has a course entitled, World History Overview. This course not only relies much on Genesis 1-11, it also focuses on the seven major background nations of the Bible. Furthermore, since all 66 books of the Bible are studied twice at NBBS (by survey and exposition), and in the order they are given in the Bible, students also receive a thorough study of Israeli and Bible history. The curriculum of NBBS further includes Church History, Baptist History, and the History of Missions, as required courses. In one of the English courses, the history of the English language is included. In varying degrees, the theological courses convey the history of doctrine. In the Apologetics course, Biblical archaeology is studied. When studying Bible prophecy in several courses, students are even learning history written beforehand! This all serves to further setoff the drama of Galatians 4:4-5, "...when the fullness of time was come, God sent forth His son, made of a woman, made under the law, to redeem that were under the law..." (Matthew 5:17, Romans 10:4).
